Patient Challenges

✓ Caries Ages +6

√ Adult coronal and root caries

ADA* | There is a benefit of APF gel (1.23% fluoride) application up to every three months for 4 minutes for caries for ages 6–18. The panel found no studies regarding the effect of 1.23 percent fluoride (APF) gel on coronal caries of adults older than 18 years, but they extrapolated the evidence from permanent teeth of children 6 through 18 years of age to recommend (at the strength of expert opinion) for this age group.



A topical Acidulated Phosphate Fluoron (APF) anti-caries preparation gel containing 1.23% fluoride ion from sodium fluoride and hydrofluoric acid with low pH

Recommended for children and adults without composite and porcelain dental restorations, crowns or bridges

Thixotropic gel minimizes risk of patient gagging/ingestion, maximizes contact with all tooth surfaces

Adheres closely to the enamel and interproximal areas
